This picture is showing freedmen being able to vote after the war.

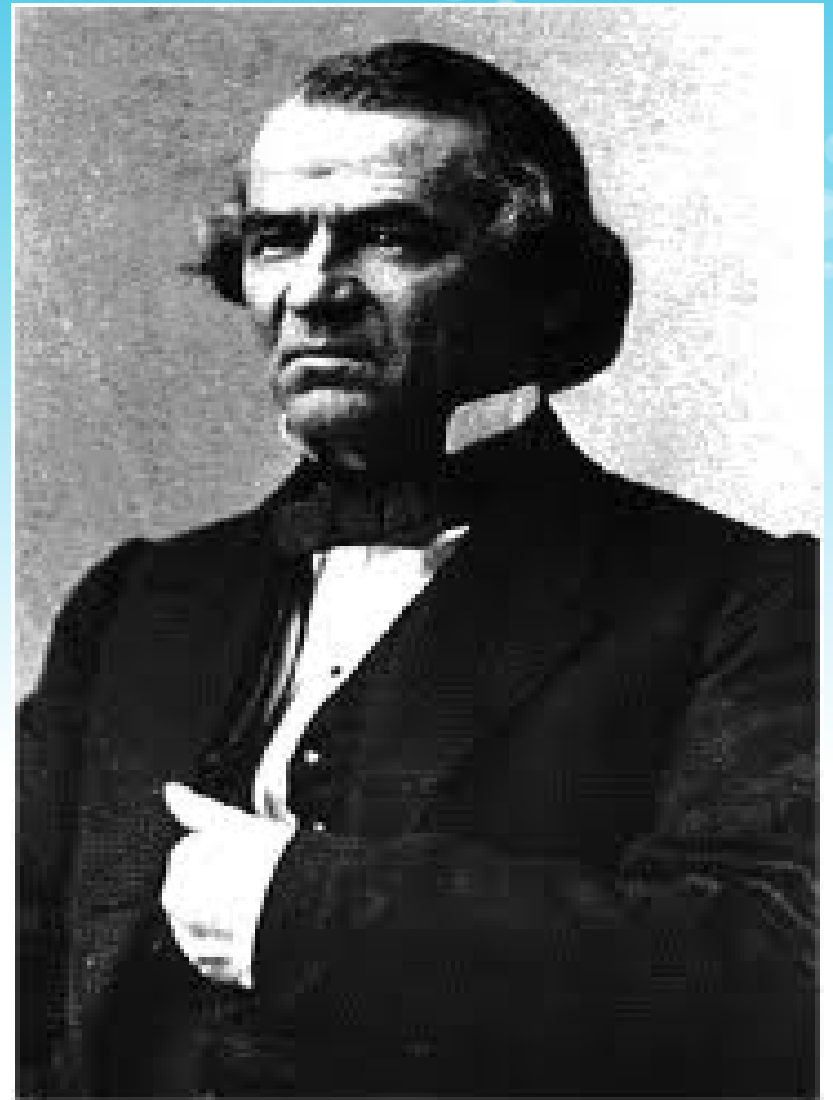


This is a cartoon showing lincoln and johnson repairing the union.

This is a picture showing Johnson giving more freedom to the slaves.



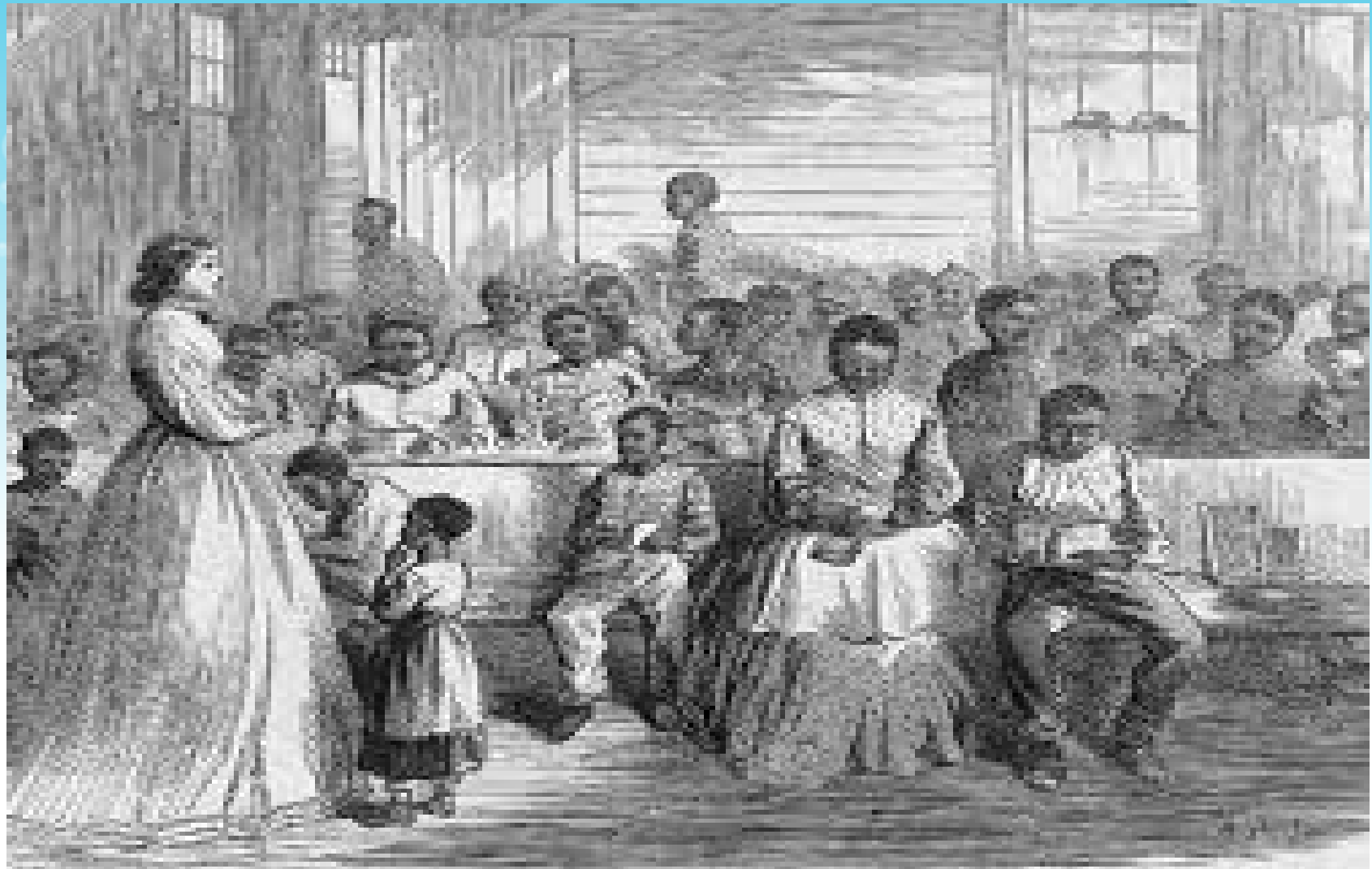
This is a picture of black men who became congress men and lawmakers after the war.

These pictures above are showing people using sharecropping as a way to save money during reconstruction.

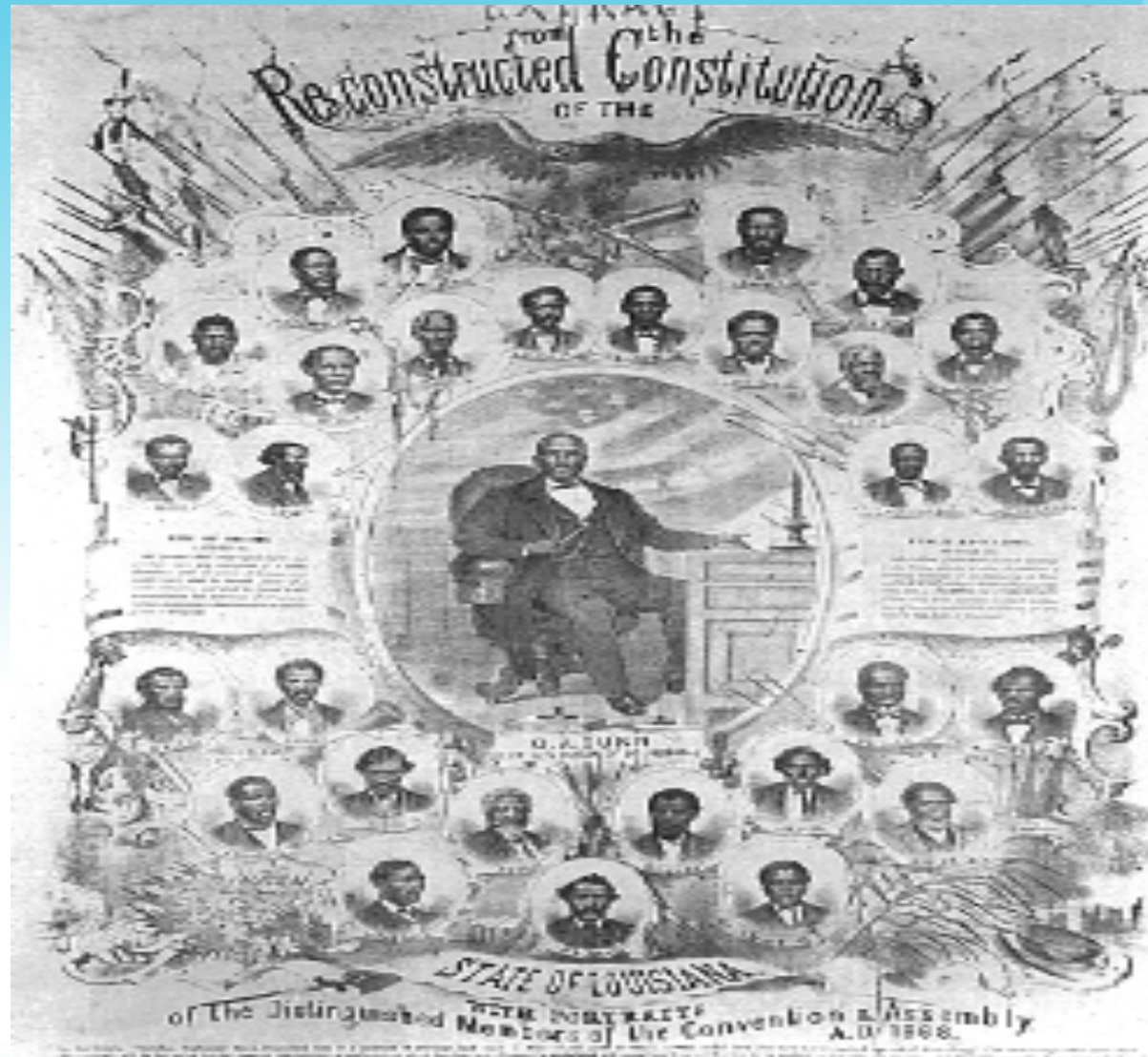


This is showing blacks learning in school.
