



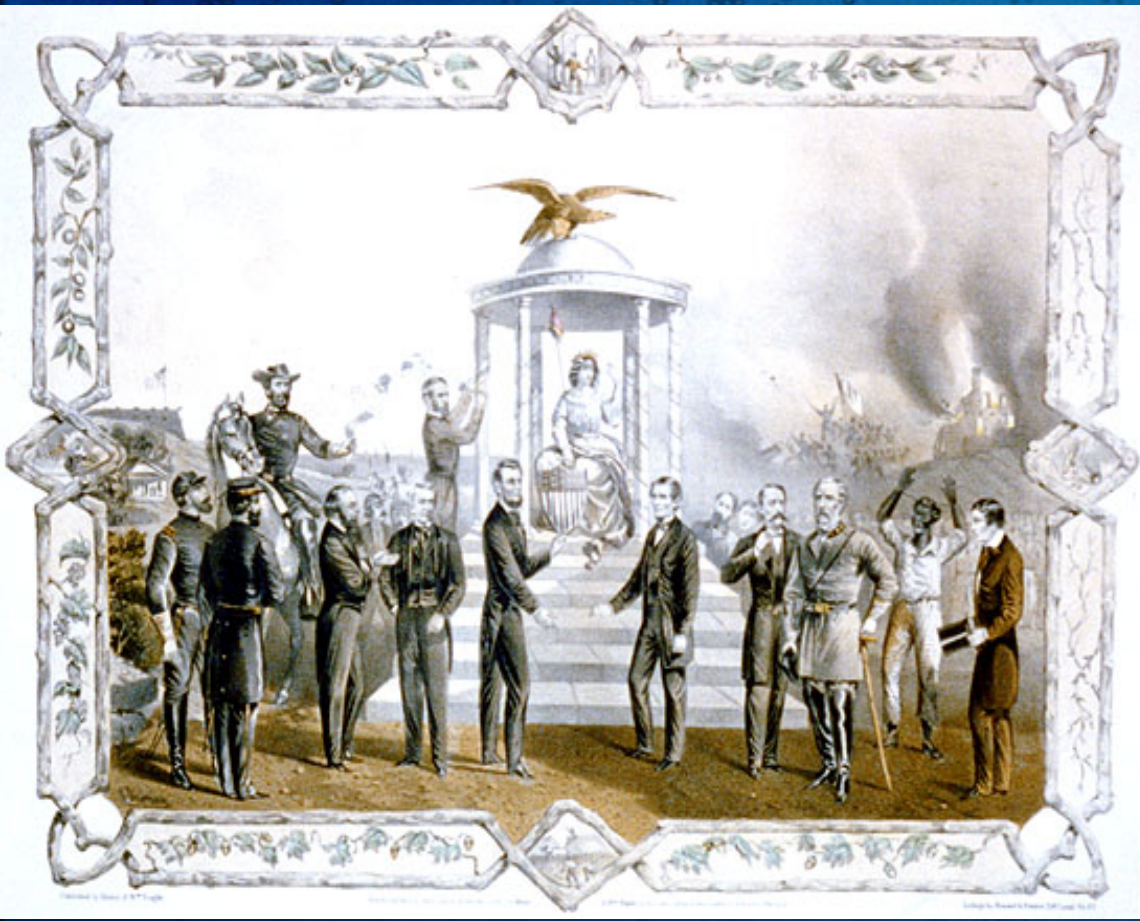
The Faces of Reconstruction

Political cartoon with Andrew Jackson talking with Abraham Lincoln about reconstruction.



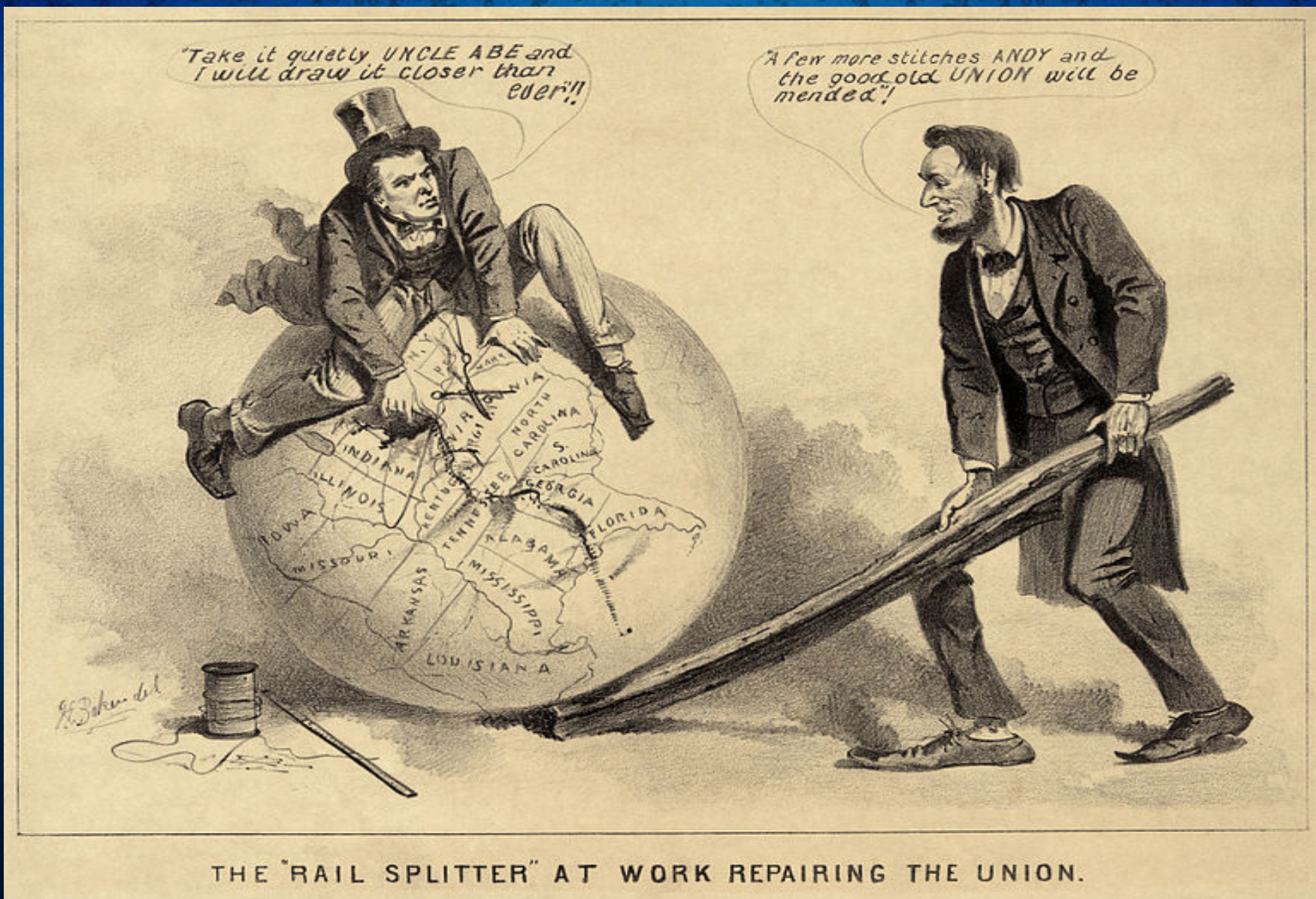
The joining of rails, utah, 1865

southern Civil War losses.*



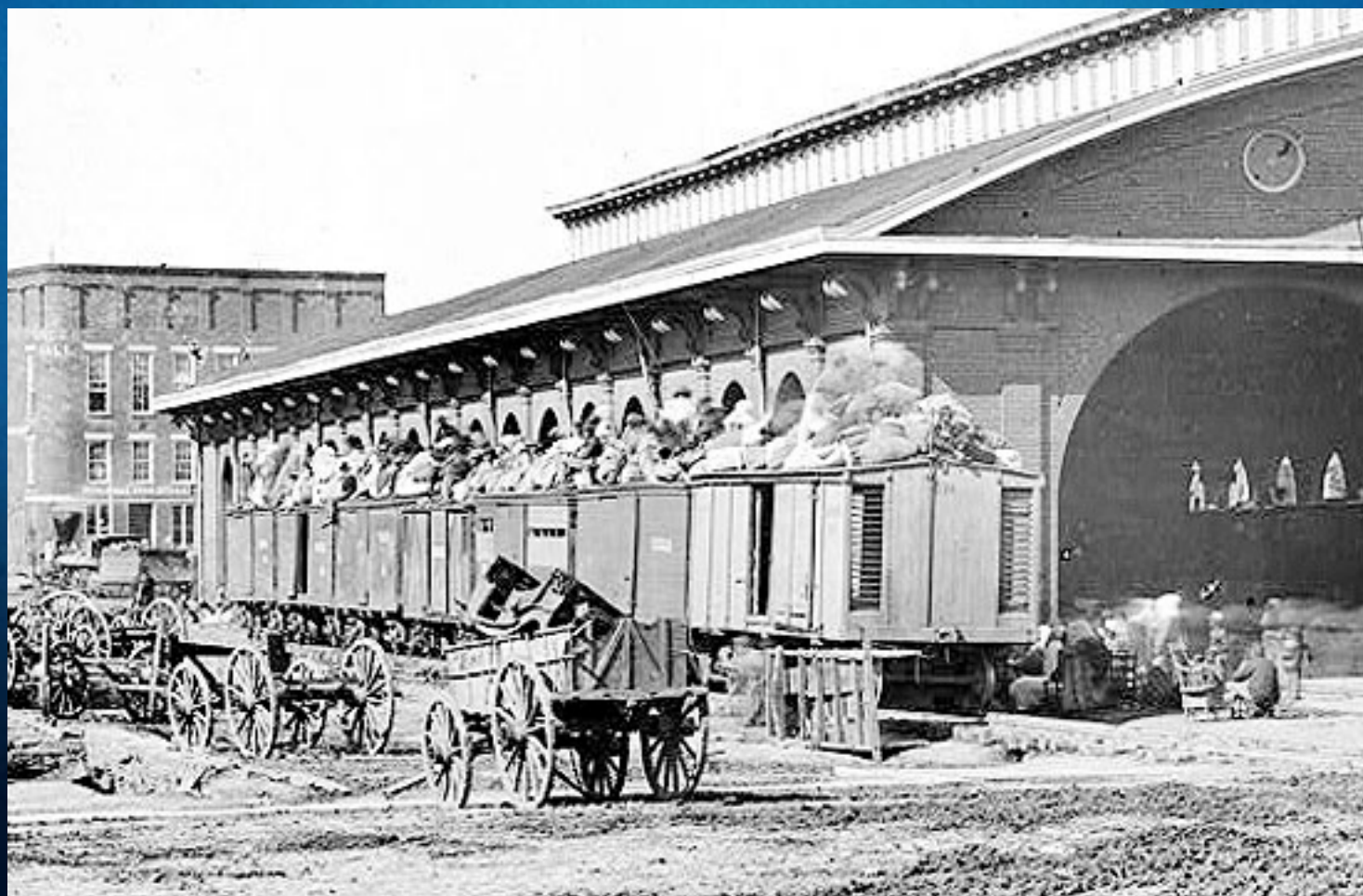
*During Reconstruction
